

CALIFORNIA MASONIC CODE

CHAPTER 5 **OFFICERS**

§805.010. OFFICERS. The officers of a Lodge are Master, Senior Warden, Junior Warden, Treasurer, Secretary, Chaplain, Senior Deacon, Junior Deacon, Marshal, Senior Steward, Junior Steward, Tiler and other officers as the Lodge may deem proper to appoint.

Master. The Senior Warden Junior Warden, Treasurer and Secretary shall be elected in conformity with this Code. The other officers shall be appointed by the Master. Any Master Mason in good standing, whether or not a member of the Lodge, may be appointed Tiler or Organist. All other officers shall be members in good standing of the Lodge. A member may not be Master, Warden or Secretary, or any combination thereof, of two or more Lodges (other than Research Lodges and Historic Lodges) at the same time.

No one may hold more than one office in a Lodge at the same time. The title of Master applies not only to him who has been elected and installed as Master, but to either of the Wardens while acting as Master.

Seats in the East

You should not take a seat in the East with- out special invitation by the Master. You will note that during the ceremony of opening the Lodge the Master invites all Masters and Past Masters to take seats there. Past Masters have served their Lodges long and faithfully and the Master recognizes their devotion by this special invitation and asks them to sit near him in the East where they once ruled. The custom is extended, on rare occasions, to distinguished visitors or any person whom the Master wishes particularly to honor. Obviously if all who chose took seats in the East, the Master would have no opportunity to extend this courtesy.

In accepting such an invitation, Past Masters and other well informed brethren do not pass between the Master and the altar unless the Lodge is "called off". This is a courtesy to the Master. No penalty attaches to its violation but it is not good form to do so.

The theory of this usage is that the Great Lights are essential to a regular Lodge and are the particular care of the Master; hence they should not be out of his sight for an instant.

As a courtesy to the Master, permission should always be obtained to approach the East, or to cross the Lodge, during a stated meeting, or at a special meeting while no degree is being conferred. If absolutely neces- sary to cross during the work, you should always await a favorable opportunity and then go quietly to the West, obtaining permission from the Senior Warden who represents the Master in such an emergency.
